# Evening Autumn 2012 Season

## HOW TO ENTER:

- Team Captain must be 18 years old or over. Please ensure to complete the form in full using blue or black pen and block letters. Don't forget to sign the Terms and Conditions on first page. If any Team Members play with a VNL Club, note on the back page beside their name. VNL Players must play in the top section and play six games to qualify for finals. In particular for new teams, please complete the grading questions and comments on the second page to assist with grading.
- **Complete** entry forms must be submitted by the **week starting Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2011** with the Team Entry Fee of \$66.00 per team to secure your spot. ***\*\*Please note that teams missed out last season due to the popularity of some competitions, in particular Ladies Evening competitions. Preference will be given to current teams but they must have their forms in and entry fee paid by the due date.***
- It is important to read over and fill out your Time Slot Preference on the bottom of the second page. By numbering your time preferences, our computer fixturing system matches your preferred times with other Teams in your grade and produces a varied playing fixture. Please note that we will endeavour to cater for all teams where possible
- Your Team Captain will be notified of your first game time by SMS (Mobile Phone text message) or phone call. Team Fixtures can be collected on your first game and can also be accessed via the internet on [www.fdna.com.au](http://www.fdna.com.au)
- Every Player must be a 2012 Member of Netball Victoria because you are entering to play with a Netball Victoria Affiliated Association. ALL Players, Coaches, Umpires and Officials in Victoria are required to pay an annual membership fee which includes an insurance component. Memberships can be purchased from the stadium canteen. Registration is from 1/1/2012 to 31/12/2012. See [www.netballvic.com.au](http://www.netballvic.com.au) for exciting benefits and offers that are included in your Membership.
- All Evening games are 4 x 9 minute quarters with 2 minute break at the half time interval and 2 minutes between each game with the exception of Monday Evening Premier League Competition which have some full 1 hour matches consisting of 4 x 15 minute quarters with 3 minutes at the half time interval and 2 minute at quarter and three-quarter time.
- **IMPORTANT:** Players may play only ONE game on any one day in the competition entered. A BYE game constitutes playing a match.
- By-Laws and Competition Information booklets are available from the foyer information rack or FDNA Office during business hours.

## UNIFORMS

When your team takes the court, all players must wear sporting attire of an acceptable standard in UNIFORM colour and appearance. The standard uniform at our Association is a pleated skirt and (tucked in) t-shirt, with suitable matching or dark sports briefs. Rubber soled netball shoes/boots must be worn. Three quarter pants/leggings and gloves are NOT permitted during play. Sport shorts of uniform style are permitted in ladies Competitions if ALL players are wearing them.

## FORFEITS

There are alternatives to forfeiting your match, please contact FDNA Office if you require fill-in or replacement players. Penalty incurred by the team not playing is double court fees. The fine is less Umpire fees if the Association is notified 24 hours prior to the game. For Sunday Evening Competition, a forfeit must be notified by no later than 5.00pm on the Friday prior to the forfeited match to be considered a notified forfeit. The team not forfeiting receives 4 points with a score of 10 goals to nil.
